

Our students also have participated in State level The school has provided every Football and Table Tennis Championship. opportunity to our students to make them sturdy, tough and strong through sports and games.

Laurels by the Students:

The students of this school have brought laurels at District, cluster and this time at state level literary, music and quiz competitions organised by Govt. of Odisha, DAV and various local bodies.

The students of our school have bagged more than 50 prizes in different interschool competitions. Miss Sonam Acharya of XII has snatched 3rd position at G.C. Pattanaik memorial Zonal level English Debate Competition organised by DAV, Chandrasekharpur and Miss Jigyansa Sahu of X was given WILD CARD
