Provisional Admission into Class-XI Science for the wards of NON- IFFCO employees is open for the session 2024-2025. The Registration Form will be available in the school office between 08:00 a.m. and 02:00 p.m. on all working days from 20 January to 03 February 2024. The candidates are requested to deposit Rs. 200/- in A/c No. - 184001000001700 of IOB, Musadia Branch (IFSC CODE-IOBA0001840) and obtain the Registration Form from the school office after submission of a copy of the money. receipt.

However, the candidates may download the Registration Form from the website (<u>www.daviffco.com</u>) and submit the same in the school office with the print out of money receipt of Rs.200/- through online transaction or they may scan the form & money receipt and mail to school.

GUIDELINES

- 1. The students who have secured at least 60% (in theory) in the Pre-board/ Term-I will be allowed to register.
- 2. Subjects Offered: Compulsory English Core, Elective Physics, Chemistry, Maths/ Hindi, Biology/ Computer Science, Physical Education.
- 3. For selection of admission there will be an aptitude test of class -X standard.
- 4. The result of the aptitude test will be published in the school notice board/ website and the selection of students for admission will be done strictly according to the merit list.
- 5. a. After publication of the merit list, counseling and provisional admission will be held in our school premises.
 - b. The parents have to give an undertaking that the School Authorities can take any action against their ward in case of showing dismal performance in three consecutive tests conducted by the school meant for continuous & comprehensive evaluation. (either surprise test or terminal test or both).
 - c. In order to ensure a better examination-oriented preparation, it is to be strictly followed that the students have a minimum of 90% attendance in theory and 90% attendance in practical. Parents along with their ward should give an undertaking to ensure this.
 - d. The candidates will be allowed to choose minimum 4 subjects or maximum five subjects from the elective group. They can choose Hindi in place of Mathematics, Computer Science in place of Biology and Physical Education as the 6th subject.
- 6. On the date of provisional admission / counseling the following points are to be noted.
 - a. Presence of parents
 - b. The details of Admission fee (which will be notified at the time of publication of result)

- c. Absence in counseling will lead to forfeiture of claim for admission.
- 7. On the date of final admission the following documents are necessary after publication of Board Result:
 - a. Original TC / School Leaving Certificate of the previous school.
 - b. Original Conduct Certificate from the concerned institution last attended.
 - c. Original Migration Certificate from the concerned Board.
- **N.B**: a. In case of not scoring minimum 70% or failed in Board Result, the provisional admission stands cancelled.
 - **b**. In case of failure to take final admission the provisional admission shall stand cancelled automatically and no fee will be refunded.
 - c. Admission will be taken against vacant seats after taking school students.
